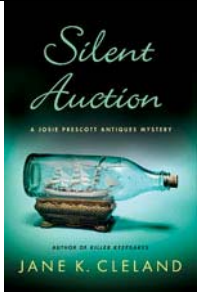

## *Silent Auction* (April, 2010)

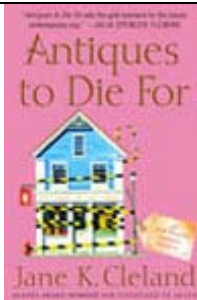

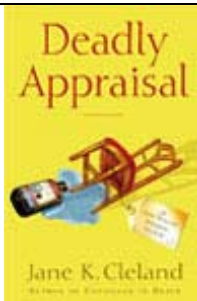

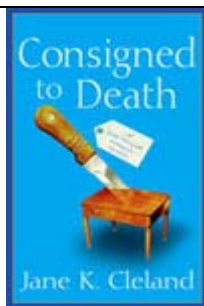
